Strategic Conversations: From advice to action, part II - Transatlantic/European defence in a ten-year perspective

All students and employees are welcome to another panel discussion in the Strategic Conversations series. This time, the discussion continues on Commander-in-Chief General Micael Bydén's military advice to the Swedish Government with a focus on how the EU and NATO can influence Swedish defense planning going forward.

The military advice that Commander-in-Chief General Micael Bydén submitted to the government on November 1, 2022 deals with how the Armed Forces should develop until 2035 in order to reach maximum defense power.

In the panel discussion, ÖB's military advice is discussed with the starting point being how Swedish capability development can change as defense planning takes on a more transatlantic and/or European character in the next few years. What follows from Swedish NATO membership and what can we expect to happen within the EU that affects the distribution of roles between countries' armed forces and their defense industries? In which military-relevant research fields are potential technological leaps likely within a ten-year period?

Vice-Chancellor Professor Robert Egnell will introduce and Deputy Vice-Chancellor Brig Gen Anders Persson will moderate the conversation.
